

For example, each press will easily handle coated stocks, transparencies, embossed papers, bond paper, vellum paper and even plastic stocks.

A raft of time-saving in-line finishing capabilities such as hole punching, saddle stitching and perfect binding are available. And thanks to an ability to work with large sized media, Pitch Books can now be created, further expanding production possibilities.

Finishing is not just versatile it's also extremely precise. The saddle finisher incorporates a facility to flatten the back of a saddle-stitched booklet. Whilst the 3 edge trimmer ensures a clean, uniform edge to every page of every booklet.

Large printable area

Page sizes up to 13" x 19.2" (330.2 x 487.7 mm) and a maximum image size of 323x 482.7 mm is printable. This comfortably allows for full bleed A3 printing for crop and trim marks.

Media library for optimum results

A built-in library with 2,000 preset options allows you to specify the exact media for use in a particular job. Once selected, the imagePRESS C7010VP Series automatically fine-tunes the print parameters, for example, by adjusting the fusing temperature or toner density, which ensures the optimum results with every type of substrate.

1 imagePRESS SERVERS
Partnerships with both EFI and CREO allow a server to be selected that has the power to meet a diversity of complex jobs – either static or variable – with ease. Powered by EFI, the iPR Server A3200 and A2200 are compatible with all devices, with the iPR Server A3200 designed for the most intensive workloads. For lighter production environments, the iPR Server A1200 can be configured, solely with the imagePRESS C6010.

Powered by CREO, the iPR CR Server A7000 v2 is compatible with all presses and is a versatile solution for hybrid environments and intensive VDP workloads.



2 POD DECK
The high capacity paper deck contains three paper drawers, each of which can be filled with a different media type for maximum flexibility. Up to two decks can be attached at any one time for a maximum capacity of 10,000 sheets. A useful visual indicator on each cassette helps keep track of the remaining media for maximum uptime.



3 MAIN UNIT
A large graphically driven touch-screen display makes device operation simple and is easily viewable from the end of the floor. Help menus guide operators through more complex functions should they encounter a problem.

Choose from three alternative models:

The **iPR C6010** prints at 61 images per minute and slows down on heavy media.

The **iPR C6010VP** prints at 61 images per minute on all media up to 325 gsm.

The **iPR C7010VP** prints 71 images per minute on all media up to 325 gsm.



4 HIGH CAPACITY STACKER
The high capacity stacker allows for heavyweight document production with a stacking capacity of 5000 sheets. An additional stacker can also be configured for a maximum of 10,000 sheets. A built-in removable dolly enables documents to be easily relocated for off-line finishing.



5 FINISHER
The finisher has a capacity of 5,000 sheets and a stapling capacity of 100 sheets. Single and double stapling options are provided for added versatility.

SADDLE FINISHER
The new saddle finisher carries out all the functions of the finisher but additionally enables you to produce outstanding saddle-stitched booklets of up to 100 pages (80 gsm).

6 OPTIONAL
Punch unit: The optional punch unit can be added to create hole-punched documents for customers. Two different hole punch units, offering either 2 or 4 hole punch registration, can be configured.

7 Document inserter: The document inserter enables heavy and pre-printed media from a different source to be added to jobs, for an added professional touch.



ADDITIONAL FINISHERS
Perfect binder: This enables quality perfect bound books to be created. Low temperature hot glue technology binds the book and cover, whilst precise 3-edge trimming creates a professional finish.



Professional Puncher: For advanced punching such as plastic comb, twin loop and pro click, the professional puncher can be configured. Punching patterns are available as die sets when can be easily changed by the user.



Booklet trimmer: To prevent shingling, this enables a common edge to be created on booklets generated via the saddle finisher. Add a further trimming accessory and three-sided trimming is possible, for a highly professional finish.
